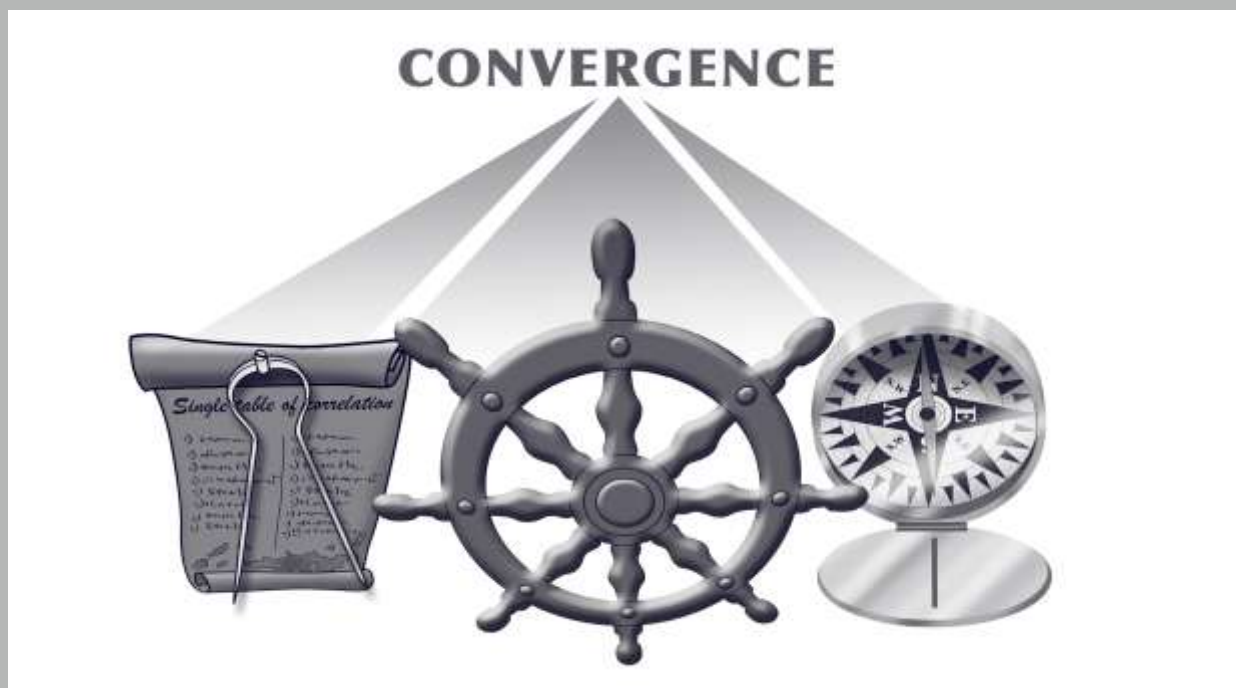

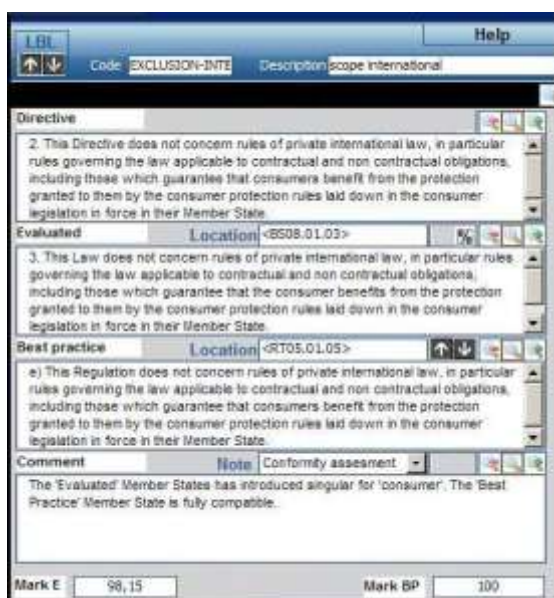

## Mutual evaluation Module

The Mutual evaluation Module (MeM) is an Internet Protocol which facilitates comparison, evaluation and benchmark by interested parties (citizens and stakeholders) of the national measures transposing and implementing a Directive.

The purpose of MeM is to:

- Assess conformity of transposition.
- Evaluate convergence of implementation.
- Track progress between evaluations.
- Provide a code of comparative law and a map for good practice.

The MeM does not only display the provision of the directive and the text of the evaluated national measure. The interested party can also compare in one common language the evaluated measure to the measures adopted in the other Member States. Best practice may be identified, valued and justified. Mutual evaluation process can cover detailed implementation as well as general transposition.

The comprehensive evaluation sheet provides an overall evaluation for each national measure and for each Member State. Detailed comment reports value and justify the best practice which all the Members of the Single Market can share.
